MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

On a volunteer and non-profit basis the objective of the society are to promote Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese medicine (TCM) in Nova Scotia. On a volunteer and non-profit basis we want to bring together and support qualified, ethical professionals to further the establishment of standards, education for the public, continuing education of our members and the regulation of our profession. Ultimately, as an altruist calling, with no agenda to profit from our association's activities, we want to ensure our practitioners work safely, within their scope of practice and with caring and respect for the optimum health and well being of the people of Nova Scotia.

To acquire by way of grant, gift, purchase, bequest, devise or otherwise real and personal property and to apply such property to the realization of the objects of the society.

To buy, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or desirable in the carrying out of the objects of the society.

Provided that:

- The society shall not carry on any trade, industry or business;
- All funds shall be used solely for the purposes of the society and the promotion of its object

Upon dissolution of the society and after payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed or disposed of to a non-profit organization in Canada having objectives similar to those of the society.
